Main Purpose of Job:

Supervise children during breakfast and play. Prepare and serve non-cooked breakfast.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. To prepare the dining area to include moving and setting up tables and chairs and to wash up dishes
- 2. Prepare and serve a simple uncooked breakfast (cereal, fruit, toast).
- 3. To interact positively with children to encourage them to engage in meaningful and constructive activities, and to deal with emergencies that may occur.
- 4. To assist children in preparing for meals including hand-washing, helping children with the correct use of cutlery, promoting good table manners and encouraging children to eat a variety of foods.
- 5. Be responsible for children during outdoor activities and ensure a first aid box is taken outside during outdoor activities.
- 6. To administer minor first aid (as trained) and assist with sick children where necessary. To comply with the school's first aid policies and procedures, ensuring all accidents are recorded appropriately.
- 7. Deal with any behavioural concerns promptly and ensure that, where necessary these are recorded, the headteacher and/or Wraparound Care Leader is informed.
- 8. Be aware of all policies and procedures.
- 9. To be aware of and work in accordance with the school's child protection policies and procedures in order to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and to raise any concerns relating to such procedures which may be noted during the course of duty.
