The main purpose of this role is to work as part of the ELS team to deliver library services to primary schools in Cornwall. You will visit schools to carry out work in school libraries, process book stock and project box requests, carry out administration tasks and be part of delivering events and activities for school children. The role will also have the opportunity to work with the EY library and the Library Resources team to gain knowledge, skills and expertise across the library service.

The ideal candidate for this role needs to be experienced at adapting to change and implementing new and exciting ideas and processes to help to achieve a dynamic and innovative service.


