This position is for a SEND Teaching Assistant 18 hours per commencing ASAP.

#### Job Overview

Devoran School is looking to appoint an experienced and enthusiastic TA to work with and support a SEN child on a 1:1 basis. This position will be for a total of 18 hours per week to include Lunchtime Supervisory hours. This roles will commence from 1st January – or as soon after - and will be fixed term until 31/7/2025.

We are looking for a team player who will complement our committed and vibrant team. Devoran School is situated on the outskirts of Truro set on wonderful grounds. We like to take the learning outside and make the most of every moment we have the children in our care. We are a team of 32 staff working from EYFS through to Year 6 in a one-form entry school.

The mental health of our children and staff is paramount to us and we work hard to ensure that our Trauma-Informed practice supports all children and that staff are also given the support they need in order to be successful within their role. #### Qualifications

- Previous experience working with children in a nursery or early childhood education setting is highly desirable.
- Strong communication skills in English, both verbal and written, to effectively interact with children, parents, and colleagues.
- Demonstrated leadership abilities to guide and support children during activities.
- A genuine passion for childcare and early childhood education, with an understanding of child development principles.
- Ability to manage multiple tasks while maintaining a calm and positive attitude.
