
- Thin card (e.g. an old cereal box)


- 1. If using A4 paper follow these instructions before you get started, with the help of an adult:
  - a. Place the paper on the table (portrait)
  - b. Hold the top right corner of the paper and fold it towards the lower left side so the paper forms a right-angle triangle. There should be a small rectangular section left at the bottom.
  - c. Cut the rectangular section off using scissors and unfold the paper
- 2. With the help of an adult make an origami envelope, following these instructions:
  - a. Place the square paper on the table so its corners are in a diamond shape
  - b. Fold the left corner in so it meets the middle of the paper
  - c. Fold the right corner in so it meets the middle of the paper
  - d. Fold the bottom point into the middle
  - e. Add glue or sticky tape to stick the bottom fold to the two sides of the envelope
- 3. Get creative! Decorate your envelope using colouring pencils, pens or paint. You could draw a picture of an acorn and add your very own special message just like Postman Bear, or even draw your favourite Acorn Wood character!
- 4. Ask an adult to help you pierce holes either side, thread string or ribbon through the holes and knot together to hang around your neck (making sure it's not too tight).



















### No printer no problem, just follow these steps!

- 1. Take a small paper plate.
- 2. Use paint, coloured pencils, crayons or pens to colour it yellow.
- 3. Paint or draw two thick black lines from top to bottom.
- 4. Cut out a triangle from another yellow plate for the bee sting and staple it to the back of the bee.
- 5. Paint or draw a thick black line around the outside of the plate and sting.
- 6. Take another plate and cut out four small oval shapes for the wings and staple them to the body.
- 7. Cut out six thin lines from the other plate and staple them to the body, these are the legs!
- 8. Now add two more cut out lines for the antennae.
- 9. Once these have all been stapled on, paint or colour them with black outlines.
- 10. Paint a mouth.
- 11. And finally, place a dot for the eye!



- Flip your cardboard onto the other side. Grab your colouring tools and get creative! You can use the LEGO® Rocket Boy as inspiration, or do something totally new!

Thread a piece of elastic or string through the outer two holes and tie in place so it fits around your head comfortably.

If you are viewing this on a smaller screen, like a mobile phone, fold the paper in half and trace half of the mask from your screen. Top tip: Use a thin piece of paper or some leftover baking paper from the kitchen! Make sure your screen brightness is turned up so you can see the outline.

 $oldsymbol{2}$  Cut around the outline you've drawn to create your mask shape. If you've folded your paper, unfold this after cutting to reveal your mask!

 ${f 3}$  Stick the paper with the mask outline onto an empty cereal box/thin piece of card, and with adult supervision, carefully cut around this and the eye holes.

**5** Ask an adult to pierce a hole on either side of the mask and thread with elastic. Tie in place.

- Once done, insert each of your three tabs into the three holes and tape them flat. Wow! You're done!
