Your child is invited to sign up for this year's <u>Summer Reading Challenge</u> with Cornwall Libraries. Sign up for FREE at your local library!

What is the Summer Reading Challenge?

The Summer Reading Challenge encourages children to keep reading during the school summer holidays – and to enjoy reading anything they like! Children aged 4-11 are invited to set a reading goal and collect rewards for their reading. It's completely **FREE** to take part.

It is an amazing way to boost children's confidence – last year 72% of children taking part felt more confident reading.

Why should my child sign up?

- They will be **better prepared to return to school** in the autumn.
- The Challenge supports the move into a new year group.
- Becoming more independent in their reading boosts children's **confidence and self-esteem.**
- The library provides free access to books and fun family activities all through the summer.
- Library staff are on hand to offer support and book recommendations.

Your child will be part of a UK-wide programme developed by <u>The Reading Agency</u> and delivered in partnership with the <u>public library network</u>.

How can my child take part? (Library OR online)

In the library. Visit your local Cornwall Library and sign up. Your child will:

- Set a reading goal for the summer and borrow and read any books, eBooks and audiobooks.
- Receive a Challenge booklet and collect special stickers and rewards for reading.

Online. Take part online.

- Sign up on the <u>summerreadingchallenge.org.uk</u>.
- Set a reading goal and get book recommendations and tips.
- Unlock digital badges and online rewards, including a printable certificate.

When?

Dear Parents/carers

This year a great asset will become available for local people to enjoy. In 2023 the Dyson family who lived beside Restronguet Creek gifted a field to the Parish Council for the benefit of the local community and to enhance the biodiversity of the area.

Earlier this year part of the field was planted with indigenous trees beneficial to wildlife together with fruit trees which reflect the heritage of the area. The remaining area will be left open with space for wild flowers and for people to use for play and relaxation.

'Dysons Field' as it will be known is situated part way along the Tram Road and unfortunately access will therefore be limited to walkers and cyclists. However the road is already often used for walking and cycling and we hope that the field will become a place where people can stop off, have a picnic, enjoy play or just relax on one of the benches admiring the stunning view of the creekside.

The field will be formally opened on 13th July and the purpose of this letter is to welcome you to Dyson's Field at any time during the summer holidays and throughout the rest of the year where we hope you will find it a great open space for the family to enjoy. Picnic benches will be available as will benches suitable for the less agile. A cycle rack will be provided to safely secure bicycles and the family pet will be allowed on a lead. However like most open spaces in the countryside toilets cannot be made available.

We want Dysons Field to be thought of as part of the community. Over the coming months we therefore hope that in addition to the field being available for you to use we will have a programme of talks about the nature of Feock and how the field fits into the natural environment.

We hope you will enjoy this new community space in the parish.






