Message from the Head

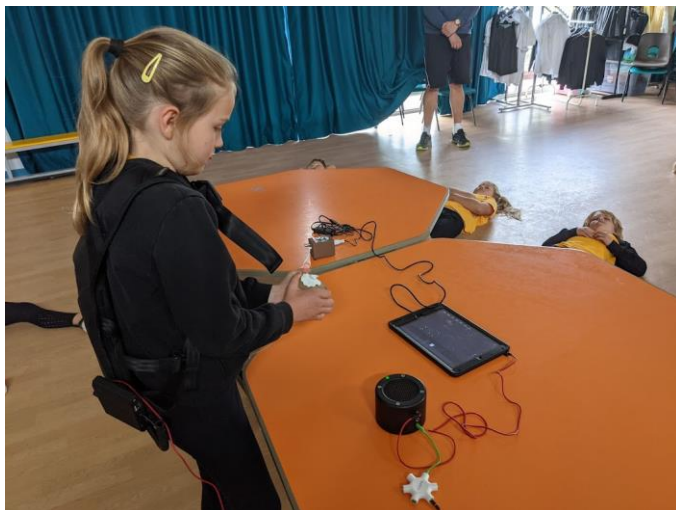
Dear Parents and Carers
