I'm writing to let you know that Truro Foodbank will be holding 2 open days in the summer holidays on Tuesday 8 and Tuesday 22 August. They will be at All Saints Church, Tresawls Road, Highertown, TR1 3LD from 10am to 1pm.

We will be offering family top-up food to families in the TR1 to TR6 postcode areas. This means that people who might be struggling to supply breakfast and lunches to children can come in and choose up to 10 items.

We will also have advice agencies there to help with information about gas, water or electric costs or to give advice about employment or money skills. Cornwall Children's Clothes Bank will also be there to assist with children's clothes.
