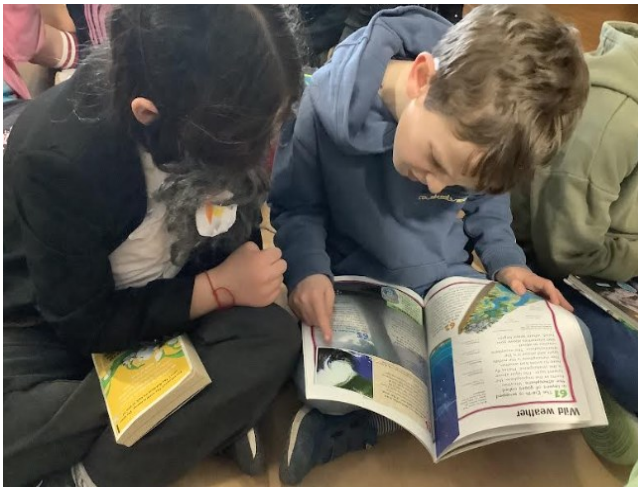

"I liked the football and basketball."

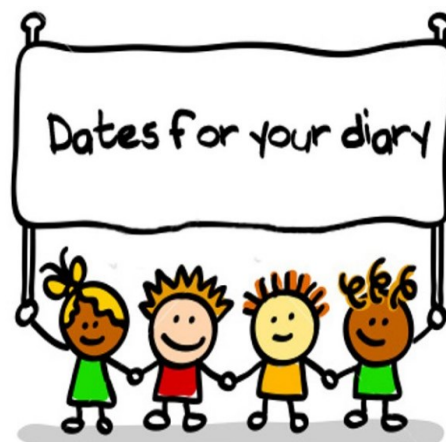
"I think it was exhausting, but nice and kind of crazy."
