Pantomime - SAVE THE DATE!




Mr Griggs ran the London Marathon!

The online application system opened last week and detailed information about the admissions process is available online at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions or on request from the School Admissions Team.

It is really important that you name more than one preference. Naming more than one will not give you less chance of securing a place at your preferred school. If you do not apply on time, your preferred school/s may already be full. Please also check your eligibility for Home to School Transport before naming your preferences.
