

#### **BICYCLES**

We are always pleased to see Hall users arrive by bicycle, but the storage of bicycles inside the Hall is not permitted. <u>All</u> bicycles must use the cycle park to the right of the main entrance for H&S.

Bicycles are not always clean. You may have cycled through puddles and mud and unlike humans bicycles can't wipe their feet. Also cycle chains can drop oil. These could inadvertently cause a slip hazard to other Hall users.

Bicycles can be a trip hazard and prevent users accessing the coat hooks easily. You may be easily able to move pass your bicycle, but others attending the Hall may have mobility and/or balance problems that are not obvious.

We appreciate that your bicycle is valuable to you, whether it was a free hand me down or cost the earth. So please come with an appropriate security device for your bicycle and a cover to keep the seat dry.
